PUBLIC VISITOR GUIDELINES

Respect the land

- Park and camp in designated areas. Be conscious of tree roots and grass that you might damage. We love our trees.
- Our roads lead to walking trails, which often are soft and wet. Be aware of signage indicating where vehicles can and cannot go.
- Trail bikes are allowed, keep them on the paths. ATVs, dirt bikes and other motorized vehicles are NOT allowed.
- Firewood may NOT be brought from off-site due to an invasion of the Emerald Ash Borer. Please purchase firewood on-site from the woodpile, using the honor box.
- Fires and outdoor cooking are permitted. Shop for steaks and burgers in the Farm Store!
- Ice and soft drinks can also be purchased using the honor boxes.
- Keep your area tidy and attractive. Deposit garbage, compost and recycling in designated areas. We do have critters that get into things.
- Leave no trace of your stay, except foot prints!

Respect each other

- We welcome families with children here. All guests under 18 must be under the supervision of a parent or guardian. Parents, please be with your children after dusk.
- If you are interested in swimming, please sign a waiver.
- Pets need to be pre-approved before arriving on the land. Clean up after your pets. Pets can be off leash for periods of time, but owners must have complete control of their animals.
- Quite hours begin at 11pm. Please be mindful of your volume.
 Programmed music events may extend past this curfew.
